### Winterization

Treasure Lake is now offering winterization for your vehicles. This will include draining your hot water tank and all other lines, filling the lines with antifreeze. If you have a washing machine, we will drain it and the pump. We will need a key to handle the washing machine and pump. The cost will be \$80.00 per unit. ### *Temporary Storage*

Temporary Storage is for thirty days or less. If you do leave your unit more than thirty days, there is a penalty of \$5.00, daily, plus the regular nightly fee. Front Desk can set you up with temporary storage the day before or the same day you want to put it in there. Space is available on a first-come-first serve basis.”

## Security Update:

"Hello from Security! I would like to thank everyone for helping the Security Officers, the Greeters at the Guard Shack, and me through this season. We had a great 4th of July—fireworks and all—with very few problems. The weather was great and everyone had a terrific time! However, there are a few things about which I would like to remind all our Owners:

1. Quiet hours are from 2100 hours to 0700 hours. I know there are Owners, who would like to leave early, and this is no problem. Just go to the Welcome Center, tell them you are leaving early, you would like to check out, and go to overflow for the night. You can get your \$5.00 refund, or donate the \$5.00 to the fireworks fund ;
2. The Park has two new RV trailers, which Owners can rent. However, these are rentals, so that means you have to check-out by 11:00 A.M.;
3. Late check-ins can be done at the Guard Shack after the Welcome Center closes. If you check in after 0900 P.M., this is during quiet hours, so you will be instructed to go to overflow for the night. *Note: Please watch out for the water faucet and electric box, when backing into the site;*
4. Check-out can be done at the Guard Shack from 0700 A.M. to 1330 P.M., or until those special funds are exhausted;
5. We have a lot more children on the Park with bicycles, so please slow down, and observe the speed limits.

"We would like all our Owners to come to the Park and have a great time. We have cut down on writing tickets and issuing reminder slips. However, there are a few serious offenses, for which we have to issue tickets and fines: \$125.00 fine for pets in a non-pet rental unit; and, \$125.00 fine for smoking in a non-smoking unit.
