Treasure Lake is now offering winterization for your vehicles. This will include draining your hot water tank and all other lines, filling the lines with antifreeze. If you have a washing machine, we will drain it and the pump. We will need a key to handle the washing machine and pump. The cost will be \$80.00 per unit. "Please remember, we have only eight rental units that are pet friendly: 1– one bedroom; 1– two bedroom; 6– motel units. There are no pet units in Phase II. If you do have a pet in <u>any</u> unit that is not designated as a pet unit, the fine is \$125.00. (FYI: Many people are allergic to pet dander, so if there has been a pet in a non-pet unit, we have to take it off-line, set up an ozone machine, wipe down all the walls with chemicals, wash curtains, bedspreads,

etc., and shampoo any rugs. In addition, this requires many hours of labor time for the Housekeeping Department.)

Security Update:

"For all of you, who had the pleasure of spending time at the Park this season, I want to take this opportunity to thank each of you for the help you give this department keeping your Park a safe and fun place to visit.

"Storage will be closed on January 1, 2016 and will re-open around March 15, 2016. If you need to access that area, you have to have a lease or have approval in writing from the lessee. Check in at the Welcome Center or Guard Shack, and they will contact Security to meet you at the Storage gate.

"Every year, I have questions about the tape around faucets at the various sites. The tape means the faucet has been winterized. You can park on that site, just take off the tape.

"The fines for pets in non-pet units and smoking in non-smoking units has gone to \$125.00. As was mentioned in the news from Front Desk, violating this rule causes not only a lot of extra work for Housekeeping, but the unit cannot be rented, until all the extra work is completed.

"I have instructed my guards to get all personnel to swipe their gate cards to find out if they work, and to prevent any damage to their vehicle.

"During the winter, we will be going through all Phases to check for repairs, and reporting these to Maintenance. We will also be replacing bad clips, signs, and posts on signs. (continued on Page 2)
