“Hello, everyone! from the Rock 'n Roll Café! I would, first, like to thank all of our customers for a very successful season this year. We are seeing lots of new faces and we hope that we are keeping our menus pleasing to everyone. If you have any suggestions for changes or for any

new items you would like to see on the menu, please let me know.

“We are very pleased with the response we have had on our fish and shrimp specials. We will continue those as long as everyone is happy and as long as the special is selling. 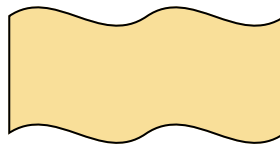
