#### Greetings Treasure Lake Owners

As we end this year, I would like to thank all our owners, employees, work campers and volunteers. We have ventured through Covid-19 together this year. We continue to adapt to the ever-changing waters of this pandemic and strive to make the best possible solutions for the park, for members, members' guests and employees.

Here is a little recap of the progress made on the park this year. We remodeled 3 units, relocated 2 rental units, replaced skirting on 6 units, added eye sensors on the front gate, added 4 pedestals, added LED lighting, outlet receptacles' and painted the pavilion floor. We replaced all the plumbing in the outdoor pool (repair cost of \$180,000). We are in the process of adding 2 new yurts, outside building of yurts is completed and now we are working on the inside. They will be available for rental in 2021.

This year we had our first annual Bluegrass Festival and it was a great success. The revenue made off of the festival was \$13,000. We also had our first Gospel Festival. This too was a success with a revenue being made of \$4,500.

Due to rising cost, the Board of Directors made the unpopular, but very necessary, decision to raise the nightly RV rental rate to \$10 for members and \$25 for guests. This new price increase goes into effect January 1, 2021.

## Activities

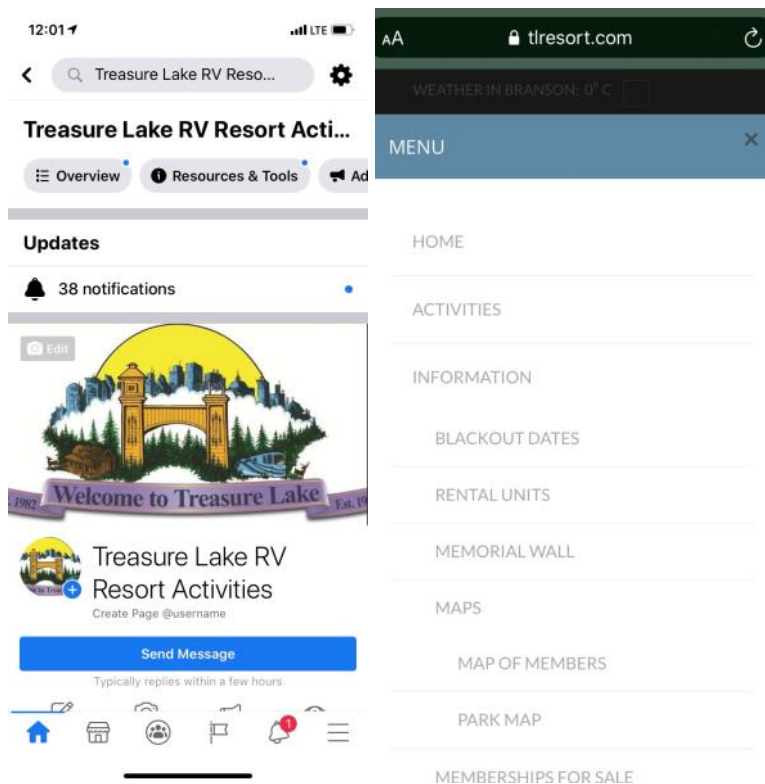
