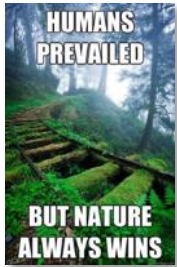
President's Corner

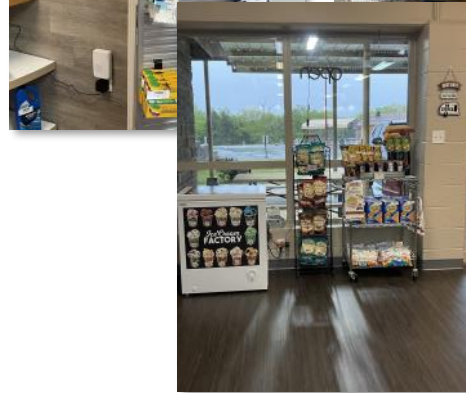
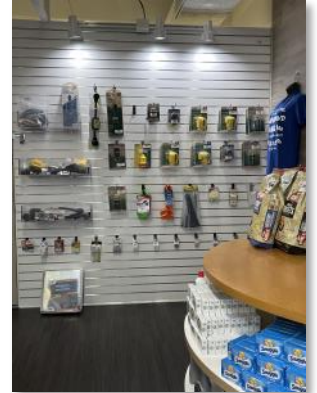
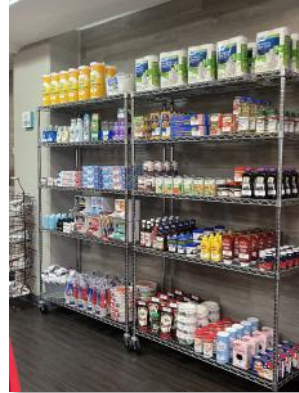
