Traffic Control on July 6

We encourage owners to exit and enter the park using the back gate when possible to minimize traffic entering the front of the park.

Security will have a dual check- in at the front entrance. The first area will be just past the IMAX entrance and only members will be allowed to move to the Park's gated entrance. Please have your gate card and/or Owner ID ready to present at the gate. If you plan to have family and guests join you for the fireworks (and we hope you do), you will need to meet your guests outside the park and have them follow you through the gate. PLEASE have guests and family join you by 8 pm. This will allow our security team to minimize lines and increase safety in our park.

The location of the fireworks will be the same as last year (in the field behind the tennis courts). No one will be allowed in the designated safety area during the day's events. Live music will take place at the Pavilion.

GOLF CART STICKERS

This is a friendly reminder that if you drive a golf cart, side-by-side, or other motorized recreational vehicle, you must provide proof of insurance and purchase a sticker to display on your windshield. This policy began July 1.

The cost of these stickers is only \$3.50. We ask for your cooperation. Security will be checking.
